



# eFONA Tea Trolley Teaching - How to

#### Personnel

- 1. 2x anaesthetists
  - a. 1 to run session
  - b. 1 to oversee anaesthetic to release attendee

## Equipment

- 1. 2x Trucorp Airsim Manikins
- 2. Multiple larynx's and skin with integral subcutaneous tissue
- 3. Cotton wool
- 4. Red food dye
- 5. 2x eFONA boxes (size 6.0 ETT, bougie, 10 blade scalpel)
- 6. 2x ambu-bags
- 7. 2x etCO2
- 8. Procedures trolley with wheels

## Set-up trolley

#### Top-shelf

- 1. Prepare 2x manikins
  - a. Normal BMI: with no additional cotton wool
  - b. High BMI: with multiple layers of red dyed cotton wool between larynx and skin
- 2. Handouts x2 (laminated)
- 3. Open x2 eFONA boxes

#### Bottom-shelf

- 1. Refreshments (tea/cake etc)
- 2. Replacement larynx/skin

## Running the session (~15 mins per theatre)

- 1. Wheel trolley to each theatre
- 2. Aim to run session in each theatre anaesthetic room
- 3. Release anaesthetist/s from theatre
- 4. Pre teaching questionnaire (surveymonkey QR code)
- 5. Verbal explanation of indication, points 1-5 on handout, technique (both normal/raised BMI)
- 6. Hands-on attempt at each
- 7. Post teaching questionnaire (surveymonkey QR code)
- 8. Signpost to DAS eFONA youtube video
