


What is Membership?

Membership is completely free and offers you a way to...



You will be automatically opted in to staff membership if you are:

- On a permanent contract
- On a fixed term contract of at least 12 months

If you are employed on a bank, honorary or fixed term contract less than 12 months we will write to you after your induction to invite you to become a public member.
