The aim of this trial is find out whether taking iron to prevent maternal anaemia has any effect on pregnancy or birth outcomes.



Pioneer

This research study is for women who have been referred to a preterm birth prevention clinic and is looking to see whether taking Pravastatin prevents pre term birth.

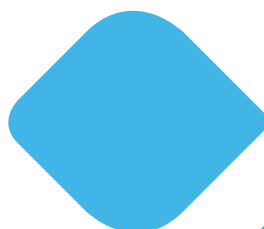


Above

A randomised controlled trial to assess the best form of preventative management for preterm birth secondary to caesarean section damage.

Vrec

This study is looking to see whether a virtual reality tour showing the process of an elective caesarean birth reduces anxiety. Those taking part are randomised to either receiving the film or normal care.
